

Family Place Grant

The Texas State Library in combination with the Family Place Libraries Training Institute has been awarding grants for Texas libraries. Family Place Libraries TM is a network of children's librarians nationwide who "believe that literacy begins at birth, and that libraries can help build healthy communities by nourishing healthy families." Linda and I have felt for a while that we need to do more in the way of programming for our littlest patrons and their families. So we jumped at this opportunity. We were both very impressed with the training and the program in general.


Watauga Public Library was awarded one of the grants in the most recent round of training. Two members of staff (Linda Evers & Lana Ewell) attended training in late April 2016. After completion of the training (which was paid for by the institute and valued at \$12,000), the library has received \$6,000 to spend toward setting up the program here. We are currently spending the money on the basic recommended items for the workshop aspect of the program. It has to all be spent by the end of July 2016. As you can imagine we have been super busy with Summer Reading and this ordering going on. Space wise we are facing some storage challenges, but we will rise to the occasion.

The components of the program are outlined at <http://www.familyplacelibraries.org/whatMakes.html> . One of the key components is the Parent/Child Workshop, which we must offer twice a year. It is a five week program that is focused at toddlers and their parents or guardians. The Library is the setting for an informal, non-threatening area in the community where they can gather, network, and improve their skills with their children. The Youth Librarian is the first specialist to "present" the program. There is no formal presentation per se. Each week the structure of the workshop is informal and basically reassuring atmosphere, that will encourage networking on various levels. In each of the following weeks we invite local professionals (Speech Therapist, Developmental Specialist, Physical Therapist, Nutritional Specialist, & a Music/Play &/or Health specialist) to attend and do a "soft sell" about their areas of expertise.

Linda and I were able to observe part of one program and we are very excited to get it going here.

The Friends of the Watauga Public Library has agreed to fund the remaining items needed for the program. These are toys to circulate, and the addition of public floor items to create a welcoming space. Some of the educational and developmental units we have are looking a bit dreary (and some are broken and cannot be fixed....they have been loved too much).




What is a Trivia Night?
